

# **Recreational Pilot Certificate**

A recreational pilot certificate (RPC) is perfect for someone who is looking to take up a new hobby in flying or take the first steps toward becoming a commercial pilot. There is no minimum age requirement to start flying training.

The RPC allows you to fly pilot in command of hours Pilot in Command) a RA-Aus registered aeroplane (600kg maximum take-off weight or less) within 25 nautical miles from the departure aerodrome.



### **Certificate Requirements**

- Complete relevant ground and flight training
- Be at least 15 years of age
- Pass 4 RPC Exams
- Pass RPC flight test
- 20 hours of flying training (incl. 5
- Aviation Security ID card (ASIC)
- Be able to hold a Class 2 Medical certificate
